PORSCHE CLUB OF VICTORIA INC (PCV) PARTICIPANT OF THE YEAR AWARD 2019

SPONSORSHIP, PRIZES & RULES

The Porsche Club of Victoria Inc (PCV) will conduct The Participant of the Year Award again in 2019. This award is available to all PCV members and is to encourage members' participation in a wide variety of PCV events. The PCV has therefore entered into sponsorship agreements with three companies to provide prizes for this competition which will be conducted during 2019.

Sponsors & Prizes

First Prize - Traction Tyre & Suspension Centre Award: Yokohama tyres of the winner's choice (subject to availability), from Traction Tyre & Suspension Centre, including fitting and balancing, to the value of **\$2,000** (prize to be claimed by 1 March 2021).

Second Prize – Porsche Cars Australia Award: Items of the winner's choice from the PCA Selection Department to the value of **\$400**.

Third Prize – Nillumbik Cellars Award: Wine of the winner's choice from Nillumbik Cellars to the value of **\$200**.

Participant of the Year Award

The competition will be open to all PCV primary members who are financial for the 2019 calendar year, plus Life members and Associate members, but will exclude General Committee members holding office during the 2018 - 2019 Club year, concluding at the AGM. Members with only family membership are not eligible. A winner of a prize in the year prior is disqualified from winning the same place or lower in the following two years.

Award of Points

Members who fully participate in events conducted as part of the PCV 2019 Calendar will be awarded 1 point.

- One Point: Competitors in Competition Events
- One Point: Marshals, Officials and volunteers in Competition Events.
- One Point: Participants in Social Events
- One Point: Participants in Register Events.
- One Point: Participants in the 2019 Annual Dinner Dance.

Included Events

For 2019, eligible events are included from the 2nd December 2018 (being the day after the 2018 Dinner Dance) to the date of the Annual Dinner Dance in 2019. Note: Club Nights do not earn points.

Full Participation

Whether a participant has fully participated in an event shall be determined by the Committee in its sole discretion, and the decision of the Committee shall be final. As a guideline in relation to runs a member will have fully participated in an event if the participant has paid for the event (if payment is required), attended the starting point (unless prevented by illness or

mechanical breakdown advised promptly to the organiser of the run), completed the run, and attended the function forming part of the run.

Awarding of Prizes

At the completion of the 2019 year (being the date of the 2019 Annual Dinner), the eligible member who has accrued the highest number of points for participation across all events (as indicated by PCV records) will be the winner of the First Prize, the eligible member who has accrued the second highest number of points for participation across all events will be the winner of the Second Prize and the eligible member who has accrued the third highest number of points for participation across all events will be the winner of the Third Prize.

Should a number of eligible members accrue equal points for participation across all events which results in a tie for any of the prizes that tied prize shall be shared between those members having equal points sufficient to win that prize.

Announcement of Prizes

The prize winners will be announced at the 2019 Annual Dinner Dance. Vouchers for the prizes will be presented to the prize winners at the Annual Dinner Dance, or mailed to the prize winners if they are not in attendance. Winners' names will be published in Porsche Parade.

Guarantee & Disclaimer

In the unlikely event any sponsor withdraws their support or fails to honour a prize voucher, the obligation of the PCV is restricted to cash compensation equal to the stated value of the relevant prize. In accepting the prizes, the winners release and indemnify the PCV, its Committee and its members, from and against all actions, proceedings, claims and demands which may be brought by any person in respect of the use of the said prizes by the winners.

Disputes

Any dispute concerning the rules, conduct or results of the 2019 Participant of the Year Award, must be addressed in writing to The Committee of the Porsche Club of Victoria Inc. The Committee's decisions concerning such disputes will be final and binding on all members.
